Introducing you to Sam, our Language Lead at Pre-School.

Sam's role is to ensure each child has the ability and skills to develop language and communication. Sam undertakes regular research into this field and attends local Language network meetings. In addition, she will help the staff to identify and support children's speech and language needs, enabling us to provide an environment that supports each individual child. Parents and carers are always welcome to ask Sam about any concerns they may have, or for information that is relevant to this matter. Sam will utilise a wide range of learning apparatus to create an environment in which children can extend their learning through appropriate activities.



We have been overwhelmed by the response we have had to our recent introduction of Tapestry and have been grateful to the contributions from families to their children's online learning journals.

For those new to pre-school, we are signed up to an organisation called Tapestry which lets us create a digital learning journal for each child. This journal can be securely accessed by those involved in your child's care and enables us to communicate more easily and efficiently between staff and parents. We hope that this resource can only improve our ability to monitor your child's progress and make sure we are providing tailored support and guidance as needed. You can add your own content to the journal which can give your child's key worker a greater insight into your child's development by seeing them in their home environment as well as at pre-school.

New families to the pre-school will be given a consent form to sign as part of their child's induction. Once you have returned your letter giving consent you will be contacted on how to look at your child's achievements and share their wow moments from home, via tapestry online. Tapestry is also available as a secure app to make accessing your child's learning journal even easier. We hope you will enjoy using tapestry and find it a valuable resource.

Outdoor play and Little Explorers

"Little explorers" is our early years introduction to our outdoor play for blue group only and is about focusing on getting children outdoors and interacting with their natural environment in all weathers in our local area. Due to the current lockdown restrictions, we will still be running these sessions but doing them in the safety of our own outdoor space. We hope to get the children out and exploring our local area again when restrictions are lifted. We hope that you will all get a chance to see these wonderful activities and fun learning opportunities on your child's online learning journal Tapestry and closed Facebook page through the coming months. We are incredibly lucky to have a large and safe outdoor play area our children can utilise on every session to improve their mental and physical wellbeing. To ensure your child benefits from this important part of their learning development please make sure your child has weather appropriate clothing.

Reminders and essentials

Winter Weather

If the weather becomes a problem during the pre-school day or where weather conditions are anticipated to become too hazardous to travel later, parents/carers may be contacted via the emergency contact details and asked to collect their child.

Please remember to dress your child appropriately for the weather.

Please can children refrain from coming in with toys and accessories from home.

This can cause problems in the pre-school as children are understandably very protective of their own toys, and the other children love to see new things. By the end of the session, they can become upset if their favoured toy is lost or broken. Comforters and soothers will always be an exception to the rule.

Please name all items of clothing and bags that your child may bring into Pre-school.

Items are easily mixed up or lost so this simple procedure will help us to avoid unnecessary upset.
